CERTIFICATE

Has Attended Certificate

Once workshop has been completed, and attendance registers verifies that Attendee has attend the full workshop, a has attended certificate will be issued.

Has Met the Requirements Certificate

Post the workshop attendees will be given access to an online assessment to be completed within a predetermined timeframe after attending the workshop, 1 week; on the workshop content, to evaluate the understanding of the topics covered during the workshop, with a required 80% pass rate (or as otherwise set by the employer) for a "has met the requirements" certificate to be issued.
